


Eight eTwinning National and European Quality Labels

After all our objectives had been attained, the teacher applied for National Quality Labels, diplomas which attest the quality level of the projects, and we have managed to obtain eight such certifications.

DECEMBER -English consonant and vowels

As a preparation, we will teach our students to read the vowel and consonant letters in the English alphabet. The teacher in charge will make a video showing the vowels and consonants for the students and we will play a game with the students so that they can compensate the letters they see in the classroom.

We will match the students and all of them will record the video and ask the partner student a question, then the other student will answer. Let's see if they understand.

Students, parents and teachers will say and evaluate their ideas about the project, we will present the videos with the padlet web2 tool and asnwering final survey. We will evalute the results at forum.

DECEMBER-Class of my dreams

Ask your students about the technological environment they dream of. Record them in the video as they say their ideas. First team question - what do you think is technological innovation in education? Team 2 question - Tell the technological class of your dreams. The question of the third team - What would you like to do technologically with your teacher in the classroom? We will combine the videos of all teams into 3 team videos and share and comment on the forum. And mentor teacher will write an article about the ideas of the teams and distribute it to the parents.

JANUARY-Some fun with web2 tools

Our teacher in charge will take a video which is introducing a web2 tool to students. We will decide which web2 will be in the forum with students. Students will watch the videos. And each team will produce three interconnected products using the related web2 tool. One of the products will be about the teacher, one about the learners and another about the class

FEBRUARY-Benefits of technology

We will tell our students to research about the benefits of technology. At the end of the research they will write a quiz where each team adds five questions. Teams will decide the questions in the forum.

MARCH-Talking classes

Students will use the chatter pix web2 tool to make their classroom items speak with their own voices. What things would they like to be?

They will talk about it. Every team student can make any object in the school speak. We will combine the videos of the teams and share them on twinspace.

APRIL-Let hands work

This month, we will do an activity with 3 main colors, each team will take one of the main colors and draw an object of that color, we will combine these handmade objects with a web2 tool called ourboox in a book, let our students imagine that they can use different shades of a color during painting. Students who will have a word book will write the meaning of English under each object they draw.


MAY-Evaluation and Final product


